JUDGING CRITERIA

All applicants will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. Community service and community involvement, particularly service to the Filipino/Filipino American community;
- b. Academic achievement, work experience, activities, and post-law school goals; and
- c. Essay.

There is no minimum G.P.A. requirement

The scholarship recipient will be selected and notified by the FLOWF Scholarship Committee. The award will be presented at the **FLOW Annual Barrio Fiesta (Dinner) on Saturday, October 14, 2017.**
